### Topic of Discussion at Annual Meeting

The Steering Committee was approached about possibly selling the Ministry Center to the Giles County Ambulance Service. We agreed to show the facility to their director, Roy Griggs, and later to the County Executive, Melissa Green. Both expressed interest in acquiring the building and grounds. It was explained to both individuals the decision to sell would be made by the Executive Board of the Giles County Baptist Association.

It should be noted, the Steering Committee is not trying to sell the center. We heard there might be an interest and that has been confirmed. It seems the next step is to get an appraisal of our center and grounds and see what it might be worth.

At the heart of the question to sell or not, is how the Association can use the Ministry Center. If we can use the Center, then let's keep it. But if we can't use it, then perhaps we sell it.

Regarding the use of the Center, we can host an event in the gym, provided the weather cooperates and that happened with the Youth Evangelistic Conference (YEC) several months ago. However, the last event, Expository Preaching Conference, was moved to the First Baptist Church, Pulaski, Fellowship Hall, due to space requirements and to avoid the stairs to the Ministry Center Conference Room.

Also, it's been mentioned one of our churches might be interested in purchasing the facility.

Clearly the Sell/No Sell topic is of interest to most of us. Towards that end, we'll discuss the topic at our Annual Meeting on October 12, 2021. And we'll determine if getting an appraisal is an appropriate step to take.
